- "Donuts with Dad" is scheduled for Wednesday, May 26th at 7:30am. A note will go home with the kids some time this week. We will call the people on the sign-up sheet to help with set-up, clean-up, shopping and baking.
- The Honor Roll Breakfast will be on Wednesday, June 2nd at 7:30am. Bonnie has made up the invitations and ordered the trophies. We have decided to give everyone who has made the honor roll this year a trophy because we are working on a Trimester rather than Quarterly schedule. We will need volunteers to help with shopping for food, set-up and clean-up.
- Fun Day will be held on June 7th this year with a rain date of June 8th. Sandy suggested that we get a dunk tank for Fun Day to help raise funds for the Playground Fund. She said that Mr. P wasn't thrilled with the idea since he would probably be the one who would have to be dunked. We will order a bouncer and Sno-Cone machine for the event. We will start calling the people on the sign-up sheet to get people to help with set-up, clean-up, organizing games, face painting, etc. Bonnie spoke to Miss Sue about the menu already.
